(Must be taken with a BSc Major)

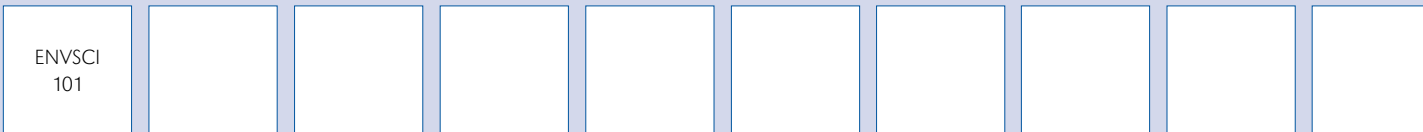
For **NEW STUDENTS** to The University of Auckland, commencing BSc Degree under current regulations (2006 onwards).

BSc Degree requires: 360 points (24 '15-point' courses). Each box represents one 15-point course.

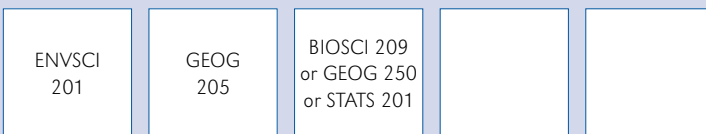
Stage I



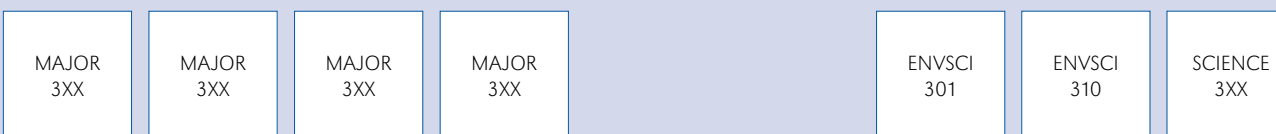
Note: No more than 180 points (12 courses) at Stage I. Can also be filled by Stage II or III.

The Environmental Science specialisation **MUST** be taken in conjunction with a BSc major. Please refer to the University Calendar for regulations on the BSc major requirements.

Note:

1. Courses in a minimum of three subjects listed in the BSc schedule.
2. No more than 180 points (12 courses) from Stage I courses (includes General Education Courses if done as Stage I).
3. At least 180 points (12 courses) must be above Stage I.
4. At least 60 points (4 courses) Stage III, plus 15 points (1 course) Stage III from BSc Schedule.
5. 30 points (2 courses) must be taken from the General Education Schedule.
6. Up to 30 points (2 courses) may be taken in courses outside the Faculty.

It is the student's responsibility to check that the final programme complies with University Regulations. The Faculty of Science is the final authority on all BSc regulations.
